# The Accuplacer Test

**You may have been hearing something about the Accuplacer, which is being taken by some of our students here at HHS. The following will give you more information about the test:**

Q: Who is taking it?

A: Sophomores and juniors. Test is taken for sophomores if they scored lower than 42 on critical reading and mathematics. Juniors take it if they scored lower than 46 or failed ECA two times.

Q: What is the test?

A: This test comes from the College Board (Makers of SAT) and it is a diagnostic assessment useful for remediation.

Q: Where will this be administered?

A: It will be taken at Hebron High School on April 16, 17, and 18. Test will be taken on computers.

Q: Why is this being administered?

A: Because of a law that was passed in the General Assembly.

Q: How much does it cost?

A: The test is free for students; the state pays for testing materials
